## What is the Catch-up Premium?

The DfE has allocated £350 million for a National Tutoring Programme, intended to deliver proven and successful tuition to the most disadvantaged and vulnerable young people.

Post-16 providers such as Longley Park Sixth Form are allocated funding for the National Tutoring Programme to provide individual and small group tuition to students who do not already have grade 5-9 in GCSE English and/or Maths

Longley Park has been allocated £146,000 to support students in this group.

In line with DfE guidance, this money will be used to provide Targeted Academic Support

- High-quality one to one and small group tuition
- Teaching Assistants and targeted support
- Academic tutoring
- Planning for vulnerable learners

Students without a grade 4+ in English and/or Maths will be prioritised for this support, however tuition will focus on identified gaps in learning rather than exclusively English and Maths.
